



Balloon Barn Farm Malawi Ride

At Kings Forest Livery, Brockly Corner, Culford, IP28 6TY
(Please do not use Culford Waste track. A byway parallel to the track will be signposted.)

Saturday 12th May 2018 from 12pm

10 miles of beautiful forest riding.

Start times staggered between 12 noon and 2 pm, so just turn up between these times. Maps given on the day.

Hi, my name is Hollie (Mary Mason's daughter) and I am fundraising to go to Malawi for 3 weeks in July 2018. The aim of my trip is to improve the lives of some of the poorest people living in this region of Africa. I will be visiting schools, orphanages and even a prison. Some other activities on my trip will include serving Phala (a vitamin and nutrient rich soya porridge), to hundreds of school children and villagers, repairing bore holes and also Project My Girl, where I will be teaching sexual health lessons to girls and giving them sanitary kits. By taking part in this ride **you** will be helping me to fund my trip, therefore helping to improve the lives of many Malawian people. Many thanks for your support, I hope you have a lovely ride.

- Start from 12 noon
- All riders to be on course by 2 pm
- Horses must be 4 years old and over
- An adult must accompany juniors between 8 and 13 years old
- A hard hat of PAS 015, BSEN 1384, EN 1384 or ASTM/SEI standard must be worn.
- Competitors may not ride in wellington boots
- Whips may not exceed 30 inches in length.
- Spurs and draw reins or similar are not permitted.
- Cyclists may not accompany riders.
- The organisers, stewards, helpers and land owners cannot accept liability for accidents, damage, injury or illness to competitors, spectators or any other person, property, servants, animals or horses/ponies in connection with or arising out of this ride.
- All competitors and persons attending the ride do so at their own risk, it shall be a condition of entry that each entrant shall indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising from any accidents or incidents whatsoever.
- By signing this form you accept these terms and conditions, recognising that this is a risk sport and confirming that you have the competence to undertake the class you are entering.
